
LUMBER PRICE INDEXES


In 2019, WWPA conducted an extensive survey representing greater than 69 percent of total softwood lumber volume produced by Western mills in 2017 and 2018. Survey data were used to construct an Index Log for each major western species. On a percentage basis, each species' Index Log indicates average recovery yielded by lumber grade and region.

Beginning with the January 2020 issue, prices shown in the Coast Lumber Price Index will be based on Index Log grade recovery percentages derived from the 2019 survey. These percentages are averages and will vary by individual mill. Percentages reflect manufacturing trends but not variances in lumber shipments.
